

Official Contest Rules

Jingle Contest (the "Contest")

Clear Channel Broadcasting, Inc. (the "Company") will conduct the Contest substantially as described in these rules, and by participating, each contestant (as defined below) agrees as follows:

Description of the Contest.

Hot 92 is running a campaign to encourage children to wash their hands to stay healthy. To do so we are going to create a contest asking kids to create a song/jingle to motivate other kids to wash their hands.

Dates of Contest:

The Contest will begin on or about Friday, August 8, 2008 and end on or about Sunday, August 31, 2008.

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. PURCHASE DOES NOT INCREASE ODDS OF WINNING. Void where prohibited. All decisions of the judges will be final.

Entry Guidelines:

Register your original song or jingle by logging onto the Station's website at www.hot923.com. Each person who enters the Contest is referred to as a "Contestant." In addition to the eligibility requirements, each jingle submitted must adhere to the criteria listed below in order to be an eligible entry of the Contest.

Jingle Entry Criteria:

Beginning on Friday, August 8, 2008 you may submit a Jingle meeting the following requirements:

- Submit one original song or jingle.
- Jingle should be no longer than :30 seconds in length.
- Permitted formats
 - mp3
 - wav
 - CD
- Contestant must be between the ages of 10 to 21 years of age
- Contestants must be available to perform at final event on Sunday, August 31, 2008 from 3pm to 4:30pm. All contestants under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at the event or will be disqualified.

Jingle must be FCC acceptable, including no use of indecent or obscene material or language. No content or material will be accepted for consideration that is illegal, sexually explicit material, or by law would be deemed to be obscene, profane or pornographic. No content which is abusive or harassing towards any individual or group of individuals regarding race, sex, religion, creed, national origin, age, disability, gender identity or expression, sexual orientation or any legally protected classification. Specifically this prohibition includes, but is not limited to, epithets or slurs (such as the "N" word), threats, intimidations, or hostile acts.

The Station reserves the right to reject any entry, in their sole discretion, based on current broadcast standards and other programming and operating practices and policies established by the Station including failure to comply with the foregoing paragraphs.

Ownership in Jingle and Licenses Granted

BY ENTERING THE CONTEST, YOU ARE VERIFYING THAT YOU ARE THE OWNER AND PRODUCER OF THE SUBMITTED MATERIAL AND THAT NO THIRD PARTY OWNERSHIP RIGHTS EXIST TO THE ENTRY SUBMITTED.

YOU RETAIN ALL OWNERSHIP RIGHTS THAT YOU HAVE IN YOUR JINGLE IF YOU HAVE CREATED YOUR JINGLE YOURSELF. HOWEVER, BY SUBMITTING THE JINGLE, YOU HEREBY GRANT TO THE COMPANY A PERPETUAL, WORLDWIDE, NON-EXCLUSIVE, ROYALTY-FREE, SUB-LICENSABLE (THROUGH MULTIPLE TIERS) RIGHT AND LICENSE TO USE, PUBLISH, REPRODUCE, DISPLAY, PERFORM, ADAPT, MODIFY, DISTRIBUTE, HAVE DISTRIBUTED AND PROMOTE SUCH CONTENT AND THE CONTEST IN ANY FORM (INCLUDING ANY TITLE OF THE JINGLE AND YOUR

NAME AND LIKENESS), IN ALL MEDIA NOW KNOWN OR HEREINAFTER CREATED, ANYWHERE IN THE WORLD, FOR ANY PURPOSE.

Publicity Release:

Additionally, you agree to grant to the Company all rights to use any Jingle that you submit, and the image, likeness, voice, name and photographs in the Jingle or otherwise submitted or provided by you in any publicity or advertising relating to the Jingle or the Company and the Contest, without compensation or approval (except where prohibited by law).

How to Enter:

To enter, send a jingle, in accordance with the entry guidelines set forth above, along with a completed entry form by one of the methods listed below. All releases must be sent by U.S. mail at the address listed below.

Register by logging onto the Station's website at www.hot923.com and follow the Contest links to download the registration materials. Deadline for on line registration is 12:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 27, 2008.

Valid contest entries must contain all information requested. Incomplete and/or multiple entries will be disqualified.

Entry in the permitted formats above must be accompanied with an official release form available on the station's website. Deadline to enter is 12:00 PM PT on Wednesday, August 27, 2008.

Only one Contestant entry per person and any prize awarded in the Contest will only be made to the Contest entrant. Contestant must be the owner of the material submitted including the Jingle. No licensed materials will be accepted.

Valid Contest entries must contain all information requested. Incomplete entries will be disqualified. All Contestants must be between the years of 10 and 21 years of age. Contestants may submit only one (1) video for the Contest and must reside within the counties of Los Angeles, Orange, San Bernardino, and Riverside in the state of California.

Contest Procedures:

On or about Thursday, August 28, 2008, five (5) entries will be chosen as finalists as decided by a panel of judges from HOT 92.3. The top five (5) finalists will be chosen to perform at the finale.

Finals

On Sunday, August 31, 2008, around 3pm-5pm the five (5) finalists will perform their jingles live at the African Marketplace in front of a live audience. Immediately following the live performances, the audience will select one grand prize winner that will be announced that night.

All finalists must provide their own equipment, for the final performance.

Grand Prize Winner:

The Grand Prize winner will be the finalist who garners the best reaction from the audience.

Prize(s). The prize(s) that may be awarded to the eligible winner are:

One (1) Grand Prize of a \$2,500.00 Educational Fund Scholarship will be awarded to one grand prize winner.

The four (4) remaining contestants will receive a consolation prize of a four pack of tickets to various theme parks.

Prizes are not transferable, redeemable for cash or exchangeable for any other prize. If a winner cannot be contacted or is disqualified, the Company reserves the right to determine an alternate winner or not to award that winner's prize, in its sole discretion.

Eligibility and Limitations. Participants and winner(s) must be U.S. residents at least 10-years old as determined by the Company and reside within the state of California. Parties to any agreement with a third party record label, production company, publishing company, or any other third party agreement which may interfere with participation in this Contest and/or receipt of the prizes awarded are not eligible to participate or win. Only one (1) entry per person. Only one (1) prize per household for the Contest. Only one (1) prize per household from any of the Company's stations within any thirty (30) day period. Employees of

the Company, the Contest's participating sponsors and their advertising agencies, employees of other radio or television stations, and members of the immediate family of any such persons are not eligible to participate and win. The term "immediate family" includes spouses, siblings, parents, children, grandparents, and grandchildren, whether as "in-laws," or by current or past marriage(s), remarriage(s), adoption, co-habitation or other family extension, and any other persons residing at the same household whether or not related.

Delivery Disclaimer. The Company disclaims all liability for any delays, misdelivery, loss, or failure in the delivery of any item sent by mail, courier, express, electronic transmission, or other delivery method. The Company is not responsible for mechanical, technical, electronic, communications, telephone, computer, hardware or software errors, malfunctions or failures of any kind, including: failed, incomplete, garbled or delayed transmission of online entries, traffic congestion on telephone lines, the Internet or at any website or lost or unavailable network connections which may limit an online entrant's ability to participate in the Contest, and any injury or damage to entrant's or any other person's computer related to or resulting from participating in or downloading any information necessary to participate in the Contest. Entry forms in a register-to-win contest must be handwritten. No photocopies or mechanical reproductions of entry forms is permitted.

Publicity; Use of Personal Information. By participating, where allowed by law, all participants and winner(s) grant the Company exclusive permission to use their names, characters, photographs, voices, and likenesses in connection with promotion of this and other contests and waive any claims to royalty, right, or remuneration for such use. By participating in the Contest, where allowed by law, participants agree that the Company may disclose personal information obtained from participants in the Contest to third parties and use such information for marketing and other purposes.

Voting Contests. By participating in the voting portion of the Contest, each voting participant agrees to be bound by the official contest rules. Voting is limited to one vote per verified email address. If an entrant receives multiple and/or irregular votes generated by a robotic, programmed, script, macro, other automated means or other source, the Station and sponsors each reserves the right to disqualify the entrant in its sole discretion..

Release. By participating in the Contest, each participant and winner waives any and all claims of liability against the Company, its employees and agents, Sponsors, its officers, employees, members, agents, and representatives, the Contest's sponsors and their respective employees and agents, for any personal injury or loss which may occur from the conduct of, or participation in, the Contest, or from the use of any prize. In order to receive a prize, participants must sign an official waiver form provided by the Company.

Taxes. Any valuation of the prize(s) stated above is based on available information provided to the Company, and the value of any prize awarded to a winner may be reported for tax purposes as required by law. Each winner is solely responsible for reporting and paying any and all applicable taxes related to the prize(s) and paying any expenses associated with any prize which are not specifically provided for in the official rules. Each winner must provide the Company with valid identification and a valid taxpayer identification number or social security number before any prize will be awarded. Any person winning over \$600 in prizes from the Company will receive an IRS form 1099 at the end of the calendar year and a copy of such form will be filed with the IRS.

Conduct and Decisions. By participating in the Contest, participants agree to be bound by the decisions of the Company. Persons who violate any rule, gain unfair advantage in participating in the Contest, or obtain winner status using fraudulent means will be disqualified. Unsportsmanlike, disruptive, annoying, harassing or threatening behavior is prohibited. The Company will interpret these rules and resolve any disputes, conflicting claims or ambiguities concerning the rules or the Contest and the Company's decisions concerning such disputes shall be final. If the conduct or outcome of the Contest is affected by human error, any mechanical malfunctions or failures of any kind, intentional interference or any event beyond the control of the Company, the Company reserves the right to terminate this Contest, or make such other decisions regarding the outcome as the Company deems appropriate. All decisions will be made by the Company and are final. The Company may waive any of these rules in its sole discretion.

Miscellaneous. Each winner must submit proof of eligibility and sign the Company's release form to claim the prize. The Company may substitute prizes, amend the rules or discontinue the Contest at any time as announced on the Station(s). The Company disclaims any responsibility to notify participants of any aspect related to the conduct of the Contest. For a copy of the rules, or where required by law, a list of winners, visit the business office of the Station during normal business hours or mail a written request with a stamped, self-addressed return envelope to the Station's address, listed above. All entries become the property of the Company and will not be returned.

Compliance with Law. The conduct of the Contest is governed by the applicable laws of the United States of America, which take precedence over any rule to the contrary herein. Station(s) shall follow the applicable laws for conducting contests, including notice to the state attorney general or consumer affairs office, posting of a prize bond, furnishing lists of winners, running specific on-air disclaimers, providing specific written information about the Contest, etc. as required by local and state law.
